- i. A one (1) page 500 word (max.) researcher STATEMENT carrying no identifying information.
- ii. A one (1) page researcher INFORMATION form carrying contact and personal information.

Ecole Libre d'architecture, May 2018, is free – no fee for application and no fee for tuition.

All applicant statements will be blind reviewed by a board (of not less than three people) established by **state of grace**. Reviews will take place starting **first week of April 2018**. Each successful applicant's statement will be published before the start of the programme.

Accepted candidates will be notified by 6th of April

All accepted researchers in this second round **mid April** will be contacted to confirm their attendance..

All participants have the opportunity to attend as well as run a session. Although submitting a facilitator proposal is encouraged, **it will have no bearing on your application to the ELa.**

Applicants' design portfolios, CVs, websites or letters of recommendation will not be accepted and submission of any of these items will disqualify any application.



Ecole Libre d'architecture May 2018 Admission Requirements

Applicant eligibility (minimum requirements) to participate in the Ecole Libre d'architecture, May 2018 are:

1. Minimum Requirements:

- Must be aged between 22 and 101 years of age.
- Must have evidence of experience professionally or otherwise in a discipline that engages with a form
 of practice relevant to architecture.
- 2. Residency in Paris & Venise or the ability to travel to Paris during the period starting
 - Tuesday, May 1, 2018 and ending in
 - a single session in Venice on Thursday, May 24, 2018 (travelling to Venice is optional)
- 3. The Sessions will run on three days per week Tuesday to Thursday on the following dates

Week One May 1 (May Day – La Fete du Travail),2,3

Week Two May 8 (Fete de la Victoire 1945) ,9,10 (l'Ascension)

Week Three May 15, 16, 17

Special workshop May 20 (Pentacote) & 21 (Pentacote)

Assembly in Venice May 24 at the Vernissage of the Biennale. (optional)

Although ELa encourages full-time (3 days per week) participation in the Ecole Libre d'architecture, May 2018, ELa realises that full-time participation may not, in many cases, be possible. Sessions will run from Tuesday through Thursday each week with some special events or sessions to be held at other times, this programming is aligned to help those employed to participate. Ela is happy to intercede on your behalf with your employers. A full timetable will be available on the ELa web site in February 2018. ELa will ask accepted participants to confirm their expected level of attendance upon admission.

Unfortunately, ELa is unable to assist with travel costs, local accommodations, insurances or VISAS for non E.U. nationals.

4. Languages

ELa will be run in English, although there may be some sessions in translated from the French. Fluency in written and spoken English is a minimum requirement, French would be an advantage.
